
WHERE DO YOUR MICKELS 60?

Helped 174 families through 126 disaster responses, the majority of these home fires.



Collected 1,635 units of lifesaving blood from 56 local blood drives.



Provided 1,261 critical community services to members of the military, veterans and their families.



Trained 10,658 people in First Aid/CPR/AED and 1,351 people in aquatics and water safety.
