The Community Resource Center (CRC)

Adjusting to a new home can be overwhelming for a foster child. The CRC is stocked with essentials—from clothes to comfort items—provided at no cost to help ease this transition and offer a sense of stability.

Resource Family Trainings

Foster parents play a vital role, but they need support, too. With 8 hours of annual training required to maintain their license, MFCA makes it easy for foster families to access the resources and education they need to succeed.

FITT Therapeutic Program

Fostering Interconnection Through Therapy (FITT) provides therapeutic strategies and coping tools, helping foster children and families build stronger, healthier relationships through expert guidance.
