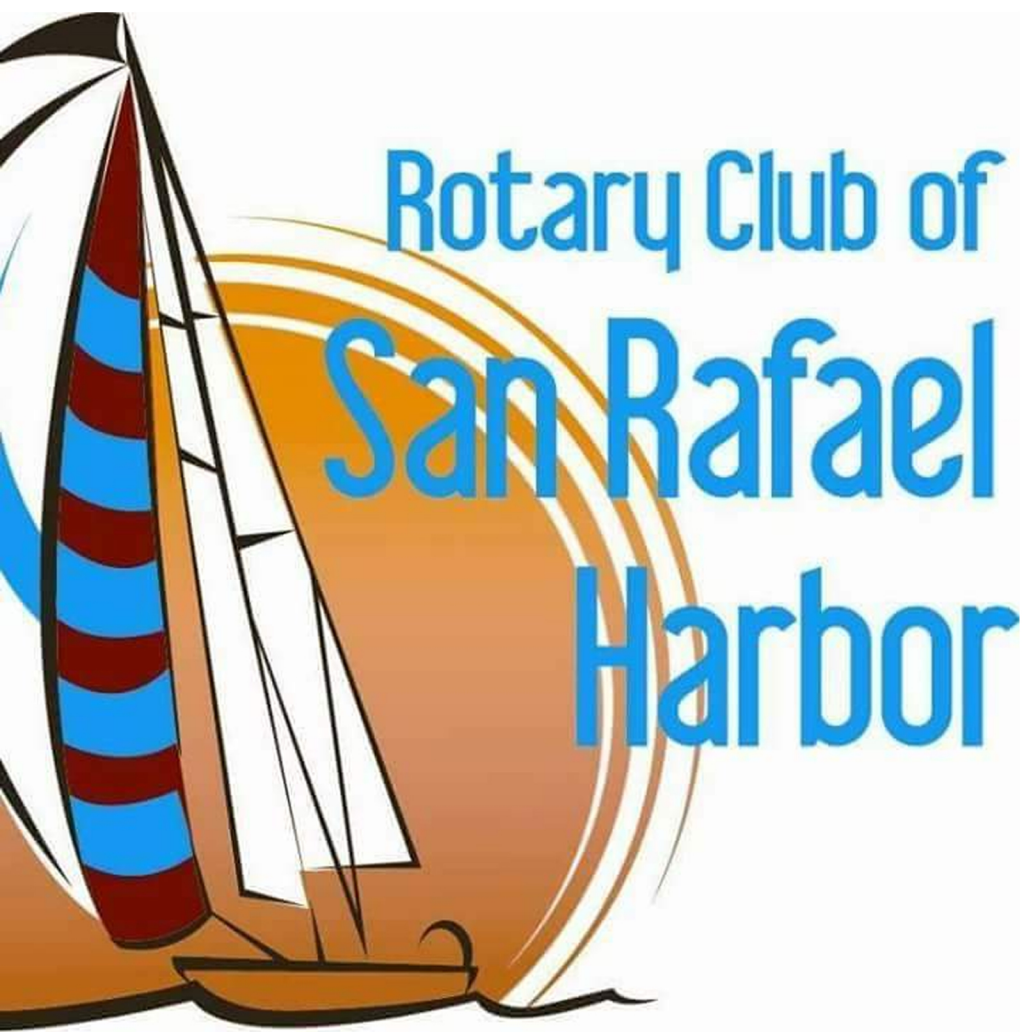


SEE'S CANDY FUNDRAISER
