TeamWorks empowers students in juvenile detention and alternative education schools with quality art classes, off-campus workshops, paid internships, exhibit opportunities, and community art projects. With sequential, youth driven mural arts curriculum students boost academic motivation, cultivate friendships, and develop pro-social skills as they collaborate to produce unique murals from inception to completion.



TeamWorks engages youth seeing an alternative path to graduation to experience the benefits of an arts-rich school environment. Keeping students in school through arts involvement leads to adults who are more creative, innovative and better prepared to deal with the challenges of the world.

TeamWorks provides a platform for historically marginalized young people in under-resourced schools to express themselves and experience collaborative creativity. Their goal is to enrich school campuses and unite communities through public art with positive messaging.



The program's resident artists are incorporated into a tightly knit support network of teachers, counselors, and probation officers. On-going mentoring relationships with students is a core component of TeamWorks' success.
