Marin Center for Independent Living (Marin CIL) is a 46-year-old peer-led, community-based disability rights and services organization that promotes individuals of all ages with all types of disabilities to achieve their maximum level of sustainable independence as contributing, responsible, and equal participants in society.

Marin CIL provides peer-led, individualized, one-to-one care navigation and other social services. Their Strategic Operating Plan includes five areas of focus: Meaningful Access to Care, Housing Support & Preservation, Youth and Family Supports, Community Resilience, and Sustainable Caregiver Pipeline.



Founded by a group of dedicated volunteers in 1979 and established formerly as a 501(c)3 non-profit in 1980, Marin CIL is the leading disability rights organization in Marin and, for the last four and a half decades, they've worked to provide our community with options and opportunities intended to help retain or re-establish independence on a person's own terms.



Marin CIL provides a critical safety net to individuals living with a disability and to those regaining their independence after a severe illness, age-related disability, or life-altering accident. They provide services to anyone in Marin County who identifies as having a disability, regardless of their ability to pay.
